
Ongoing Activities – Economic Aspects

Aqua publica europea Investments and Climate Change





Ongoing Activities – Performance

Towards common service quality standards

Converging	Variability
Information to consumer – processing time complaints – response time for new connections, customer registration, etc. – response time for disruptions	Customer care strategy – Users participation in governance – environmental commitment – Network renewal and leakage reduction

 Customer satisfaction surveys → benchmaking and comparative analysis (methodology, target groups, frequency)



Ongoing Activities – Communication

- Exchanges on innovative communication campaigns (regular). Main topics:
 - Tap Water
 - Social Media
 - Institutional communication
- Transparency and Participation → How operator/user relation is changing as regards transparency expectations



Ongoing Activities – Research Innovation

- Horizon2020 project Smart.Met → Developing innovative solutions for smart metering based on open standards (10 APE operators involved)
